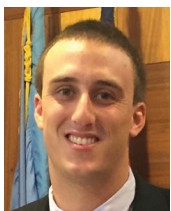

Additional High Holiday Tickets

High Holiday ticket fees are included in the cost of membership. Please note that tickets are required for everyone over age 13. Tickets for members are included in this mailing and will need to be presented to gain entry to every service. Families who are not yet members who wish to attend High Holidays with Kol Ami are welcome to do so at the rates listed below. Please use the online form to request additional tickets.

Any ticket requests received before **September 14** will be sent by mail. Requests received after **September 14** will be held at the entrance to the sanctuary on the day of services.

High Holiday Ticket Fees

Ticket fees include all High Holiday services.

Individual: \$275; Couple: \$425

- Relatives of congregants who are members of another out-of-town synagogue and visiting Kol Ami for the holidays will be free of charge.
 - Kol Ami offers a discounted rate for additional tickets for out-of-town relatives of current members who are not members of another synagogue.
- Rosh Hashanah only: \$50; Yom Kippur only: \$50

Registration for Children's Service and Programming

The Children's Service and Programming is free for those who pre-register, and is available for children 5 to 10 years old (generally K through 5th grade). PLEASE register your child online by **September 14** so we can ensure adequate supervision and materials for our programs. Supplies are limited and we may not be able to accommodate children who are not registered in advance.

We encourage parents with children younger than 5 years old to attend the Children's Service with their children (10:00-10:30 am). However, if you would like to attend the adult service for the remainder of the morning of either holiday, we will provide babysitting. Please notify us of your intention by emailing highholidays@kolamifrederick.org by **September 14**.

Yizkor

Names of those no longer with us will be read during the Yizkor Service on Yom Kippur. This will include the names submitted by members on their membership applications. Additional names may be added online. Members are encouraged to perform the traditional *mitzvah* of *tzedakah* for the High Holidays. All requests received by **September 14** will be included in the Yizkor service.

Names submitted with your membership application do not need to be resubmitted for the Yizkor service.

Gates of Repentance Prayer Book



We ask that you bring your own copy of *Gates of Repentance* with you to High Holiday services. If you do not have a copy, you may order one through Kol Ami online. The cost of *Gates of Repentance* is \$30. To receive your prayer books on time, please make sure your order is placed by **September 14**. Your prayer book(s) will be waiting for you at the entrance to the sanctuary when you arrive.

Note: There will be NO prayer books available for purchase during High Holiday services.

The ceremony of Tashlich is a centuries-old ritual for Jews to symbolically cast their sins away. Traditionally held outdoors near a stream or river, we take crumbs of bread, think about the aspects of our lives from the past year that we are not happy with, and cast the bread crumbs into the flowing water. As the water takes the crumbs away, we allow ourselves to let go of our sins. We hope you will join us for this brief and uplifting ceremony.
