- Ed: options- 1 camera, others used Iphones, chromebooks etc.
 - Multiple cameras could hit 1,000 each!
- Lisa inquired about if there's a company that we could rent the AV equipment from until we know what we want/need. Ed shared that there most likely is, but not certain if it would be financially viable or not. But worth looking into it.
- Ralene asked, "who's going to run the cameras and sounds"... We'd need to figure out what equipment we will need/use and then be trained on it.
- Jordan, "do we know what the UU is doing for their services"? Nobody is certain.
- Joanna: agrees w/ Charlie that a committee needs to be formed to deal with the tech end of it. And to work with Ed about it. She is also worried about if there's going to be enough people who will be committed enough to consistently be available to set the tech up. We are not a large enough group to have a "staff" to regularly be there to solely address this.
